



Scholarship Application

Five scholarships are awarded by the Grande Prairie and District Catholic ATA local #42 annually. The purpose of these awards is to provide financial assistance to students to further their education at an accredited post-secondary institution. The scholarship is to recognize students of great merit, whose parent/step parent / guardian is a current, retired or deceased member of Grande Prairie Catholic, ATA Local 42. The Scholarship Committee shall consider special needs and circumstances as part of its selection process.

Eligibility and guidelines:

- The applicant must be a student whose parent(s)/step parent(s)/guardian(s) is/are a current, retired or deceased member of Grande Prairie Catholic Local 42.
- A scholarship will be awarded to a student who is entering an accredited post-secondary institution.
- A scholarship will be awarded to a student already enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution and has not previously received it. Students that have applied and not received a scholarship will need to only submit confirmation of enrollment to be eligible again.
- Only one scholarship shall be awarded to any one student.
- Scholarships will be available after January 31st upon proof of completion of a semester (ex. Unofficial transcript)
- Scholarships will be awarded through a draw if applicants exceed available funds.
- All applications are subject to approval by the scholarship committee.

Application Process:

Complete online forms along with scanned acceptance letter or confirmation of enrollment from an accredited post-secondary institution.
